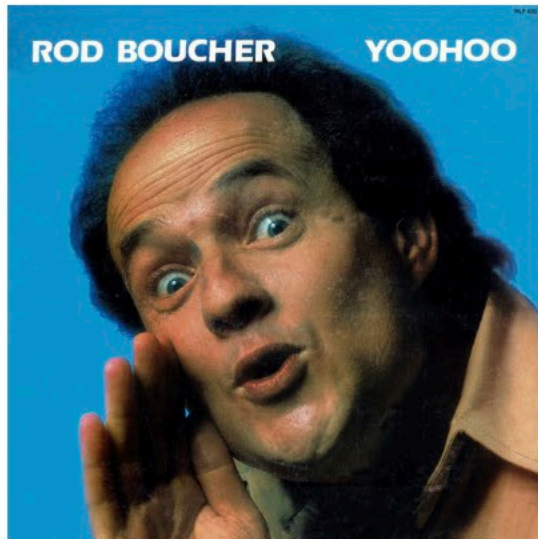
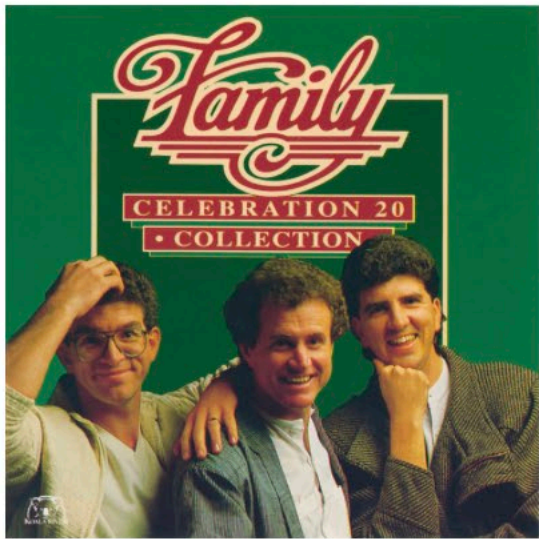


Late 20th Century songs written, recorded and sung by Christians in Australia and beyond.

The **Celebration 20 Collection** was released in 1992 to mark 20 years of the singing trio **FAMILY**. Phil Truscott, Ian Smallbone and Ian Truscott all originated from Queensland. This album celebrates some of their most popular songs recorded in the 1970s and 80s.

Recorded in 1981, **YOOHOO** is another album from Rod Boucher. This was a more 'professional' studio album released by 7 Records. Two singles were released to promote the album while touring with AC/DC for two months.

This FAMILY album includes their hit songs "Hallelujah Day" and "This House Runs on Sunshine". Band member Ian Truscott wrote three of the songs while others were 'borrowed' from American song writers. Along with their numerous Australian Tours, FAMILY toured the USA twice, Papua New Guinea 3 times and New Zealand 4 times. FAMILY appeared on every major TV show around Australia during the 1970s and 80s.

Although Rod prefers his 'raw' versions of these songs, (most are already on the SOFHAL website), he was able to introduce some great vocal multi-tracking in the bigger studio. We have included the single and album versions of "Every Little Bit of Australia" and "No Worries Luv." Time for some "good old, Aussie dance and sing" from the song "YooHoo". I enjoyed "Lean on Me" - the need to show a little love in troubled times.
